PURPOSE OF THE SCHOOL

To review the status of the most significant theoretical and experimental results in the exciting field of the new world: the Super-one.

POETIC TOUCH

According to legend, Erice, son of Venus, founded a small town on top of a mountain (750 metres above sea level) more than three thousand years ago. The great historian Thucydides (~500 B.C.) said that the Elymi - founders of Erice-were survivors of the destruction of Troy. Ancient historians agreed that Erice was

were survivors of the destruction of Troy, Ancient historians agreed that Erice was the oldest city of Europe.

Homer (~1000 B.C.), Theocritus (~300 B.C.), Polybius (~200 B.C.), Virgil (~50 B.C.), Horace (~20 B.C.), and others, have celebrated this magnificent spot in Sicily in their poems. In Erice you can admire the Castle of Venus, the Cyclopean Walls (~800 B.C.) and the Gothic Cathedral (~1300 A.D.). Erice is at present a mixture of ancient and medieval architecture.

Other masterpieces of ancient civilization, such as Motya (Phoenician), Seges-us (Elymina), and Seliquite (Greek) are to be found in the reinhourhood In the

ta (Elymian), and Selinunte (Greek), are to be found in the neighbourhood. In the Aegadian Islands - theatre of the decisive naval battle of the first Punic War (264-241 B.C.) - there are prehistoric murals in Levanzo, and paleolithic grottoes in

Splendid beaches are at San Vito Lo Capo, Scopello, and Cornino; wild beaches around Monte Cofano, all at less than one hour drive from Erice.
